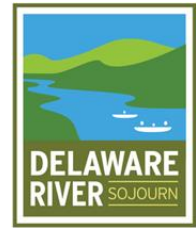

Stretch to be Paddled:

Callicoon, NY (RM 303) to Narrowsburg, NY (RM 290) through Skinner's Falls
13 Miles ~ Smooth Water with Class I/II Rapids

Morning Location: NEWE Campground 4146 River Road, Equinunk, PA (day trippers meet and park here) - see directions on page 2

- 8:00 a.m. Registration and Breakfast at NEWE Campground
- 9:00 a.m. Shuttle to Callicoon, N.Y.
- 9:30 a.m. Safety Briefing and Launch
- 12:30 p.m. Lunch at Skinner's Falls National Park Service Access and River Geology Program
- 2:00 p.m. Resume paddling
- 5:30 p.m. Take-out at Narrowsburg, NYSDEC Access (RM 290). Shuttle back to NEWE Campground.
- 6:30 p.m. Dinner ~ in camp
- 7:30 p.m. Evening Program – Wild & Scenic Upper Delaware Story
- 10:30 p.m. Quiet Hours in camp

***Note:** There are outdoor shower and bathroom facilities at this location and full shower facilities at Soaring Eagle Campground, stop at campground office and show them your Sojourn wristband. These are coin operated showers that use quarters.*

Directions to NEWE Campground

The NEWE Campground is located at 4146 River Road, Equinunk, Pennsylvania.

If your GPS has an “Intersection” capability, enter Braman Road & River Road, Equinunk, PA and you’ll be 100 feet from the entrance.

IMPORTANT NOTE: KELLAMS BRIDGE IS NOW OPEN!

NOTE: Kellams Bridge has an 8-foot height restriction. If this is a problem, participants should reach the campsite from Pennsylvania or cross the Delaware River at Callicoon, NY and continue on Callicoon Road approx. 6-miles to PA Route 191 and follow the directions from Pennsylvania.

From New York:

- North on New York Route 97, approximately 6-miles from Callicoon, NY – turn left on Kellams Road, marked with green sign.
- Take Kellams Road West and cross Kellams Bridge (note height restriction of 8 feet). The road name changes to Braman Road.
- Proceed approx. 0.5-mile to intersection of Braman Road and River Road (just past the construction zone).
- Turn right on River Road and proceed approx. 100 feet (past the red barn) and turn right into the entrance of the Northeast Wilderness Experience campground (wooden sign on right).
- Drive approx. 0.5-mile to the camping location.

From Pennsylvania:

- North on PA Route 191, approx. 15 miles from intersection of US Route 6 and PA Route 191 north of Honesdale, PA to 2nd stop sign intersection at Callicoon Road.
- Go straight at stop sign and continue North on PA Route 191 approximately 0.8-mile – turn right on Braman Road (just past Lookout General Store on left – closest store to campground).
- Take Braman Road 5.5-miles to intersection with River Road.
- Turn left on River Road and proceed approx. 100 feet (past the red barn) and turn right into the entrance of the Northeast Wilderness Experience campground (wooden sign on right).
- Drive approx. 0.5-mile to the camping location.
